A LAND OF OPPORTUNITIES FOR INDIAN COMPANIES AND TALENT

Provence and India enjoy a long history of trade, friendship, and exchange. Cooperation dates to the 16th century when Marseille was the European gateway for the Indian textile industry and today it is as vibrant as ever with initiatives such as the opening of the first Indian consulate outside Paris in France. The privileged India-Provence relationship offers enormous advantages and diverse opportunities to Indian entrepreneurs seeking to invest in the Provence area.

STRATEGIC ASSETS TO ATTRACT INDIAN TECH

Aix-Marseille features renowned sectors of excellence such as maritime trade, which is symbolized by the presence of global shipping leader CMA CGM and the Port of Marseille Fos. Meanwhile, the energy sector is expanding with the participation of Indian companies such as ArcelorMittal recently investing in the territory as part of its programme to decarbonize the industry.

In addition, Provence is home to ITER, the €20-billion scientific cooperation project to prove the viability of clean, unlimited fusion energy.

India is a key member of ITER and Indian industrial giants like Larsen & Toubro are providing essential manufacturing support.

WELCOMING INDIAN INVESTMENT

There has been an acceleration in Indian investments in Provence when the Indian IT giant Infosys opened offices in Marseille. **As Mr. Jawed Ashraf, India's ambassador to France, stated while visiting Marseille, "Provence is now the perfect place to be connected to the European and African markets."** Many other Indian companies have chosen Provence.

For example, **Electrosteel has expanded its production and logistics facilities** in Arles to benefit from the territory's connections to Africa, while the medical diagnostics company **GeneStore opened its French headquarters in the Marseille area** because of the thriving medical sector. In 2022, India was the second country to invest the most in Aix-Marseille-Provence.

The port of Marseille Fos, France's primary hub, is strategically positioned for global trade as a gateway to Southern Europe and a key partner for creating new freight corridors between Europe, the Mediterranean, and Asia.



PORT OF MARSEILLE FOS



With ample space and infrastructure, it accommodates diverse activities and serves international companies supplying French and European markets.

Marseille Fos includes two harbors: Marseille, a local Mediterranean port, and Fos, a global hub for industry and logistics. Employing nearly 41,500 people, Marseille Fos is a driving force in the regional economy, prioritizing environmental excellence. As a European leader in shore-to-ship power and LNG ship refueling, it promotes sustainable economic growth through responsible and innovative industrial development.

A leader in energy transition, Marseille Fos is a green port connecting to India through a full container service operated by CMA-CGM, Hapag Lloyd, and COSCO, and a ConRo service operated by Messina Line. Major Indian ports linked to Marseille Fos include Mundra and Nhava Sheva, with renowned shipping companies offering weekly transshipment services from various Indian ports.

Annually, Marseille Fos exchanges nearly 1 million tons, including 50,000 containers, with India. In 2008, the port signed a sister agreement with Mumbai port. marseille-port.fr
